The MWTF Tenth Annual Scholarship(s), one or two awards up to \$6,000 total. The fund was established to emphasize education by providing scholarships to female students who demonstrate a strong commitment to excellence in academics and participation in extracurricular activities related to the field of taxation.

The DKSS Scholarship in Memory of Sandra McCloud of \$1,000. In 2023, the scholarship was established to honor a MWTA member who exemplified the values of the MWTA and demonstrated a commitment to improving the field of taxation through her dedication to her career as well as to being a mentor to other women in taxation.

The scholarships will be awarded to female students pursuing a career in taxation, and the winners will be announced at the Michigan Women's Tax Association's November event.

To be considered, applicants must complete and turn in all of the following by **October 7, 2023** via email to mwtfscholarship@gmail.com:

- Completed, signed application.
- Current, official school transcripts.
- Copy of your driver's license or state identification.
- Two signed letters of recommendation with contact information (email and phone):
 - One letter must be from a guidance counselor, teacher or school official familiar with your academic work; and
 - The second letter may come from a similar academic source, or from a personal contact (not a friend, classmate or family member) that has knowledge of your activities outside the classroom (e.g. extracurricular activities, community service work, work experience, etc.).

Only one application is required to be considered for both scholarships. Late or incomplete submissions will not be considered.
